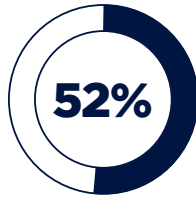
MISSION

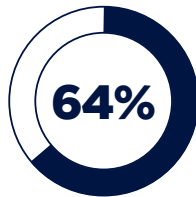

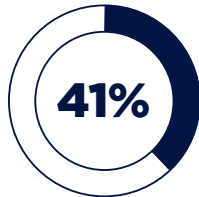

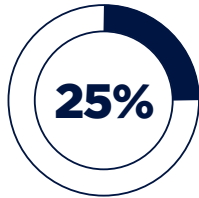

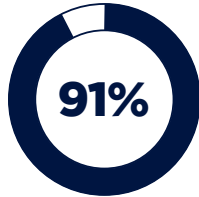


of UConn graduate students are in CLAS programs

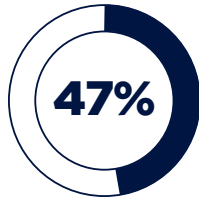


of the Class of 2024 reported positive career outcomes 6 months post-graduation
